(M) Murmansk (to Spring 1919): Flee- 50%
-One unit must always be White conscripts

(A) Arkangel (to Spring 1919): Flee- 40%
-One unit must always be White conscripts

(K) Drive to Kolchak (April- September 1919): Flee- 50%
-no type limits

Special:

- French and Dominion Infantry may be Ski troops, who may move as normal in heavy snow.
- French may also stand in for Italian troops, Poles stand in for Serbian troops, and Nationals for White Finns and Karelians.
- When choosing a Colonel, randomly pick 4 officers and select one of your choice.
- During Winter 1918-1919: Lower Flight number by 10% for all.
- (K) army Bombers may use Gas bombs (Targets within 3" radius of drop point takes immediate Fear Check).
- Tanks could not be used far from Arkangel, due to the woods and marshes in the forward areas.
