The Novouzensk and Ural divisions were merged to become the 2nd Nikolaev Infantry Division at the end of 1918, and then the 22nd Rifle Division in March 1919. It had Rifle Regiments from the 190th to 199th, the origin of some of which are shown:

- The 190th Penza RR from the Ural Division's Penza Regiment
- The 191st Balashov RR from the Samara Division's Balashov Regiment
- The 195th Novouzensk RR from the Novouzensk Division's 2nd Novouzensk Regiment
- The 197th Malouzensk RR from the Novouzensk Division's Malouzensk Regiment
- The 198th Kurilovka RR from the Novouzensk Division's Orlov Gai Regiment

The 25th Chapaev Division was formed with the 217th to 225th Rifle Regiments (via a period as the 1st Nikolaev Infantry Division and then the 1st Samara Infantry Division). The origin of some of its units are known:

- The 217th Pugachev RR from the Samara Division's Pugachev Regiment
- The 218th Razin RR from the Samara Division's Razin Regiment.
- The 219th Domashkiny RR.
- The 220th Nikolaev RR⁴ from the Samara Division's 3rd Nikolaev Regiment.
- The 221st Syzran RR.
- The 222nd Samara International RR from Internationalists.
- The [?] Krasny Kut RR from the Novouzensk Division's 5th Krasny Kut Regiment
- The 225th Balakovo RR from the Samara Division's Balakovo Regiment.
